Climate: Hyderabad has a tropical wet and dry climate bordering on a hot semi-arid climate. The annual mean temperature is 26.6°C; monthly mean temperatures are 21–33°C. Summers (March–June) are hot and humid, with average highs in the mid-to-high 30s Celsius; maximum temperatures often exceed 40°C between April and June. The coolest temperatures occur in December and January, when the lowest temperature occasionally dips to 10°C. May is the hottest month, when daily temperatures range from 26 to 39°C; December, the coldest, has temperatures varying from 14.5 to 28°C. Heavy rain from the south-west summer monsoon falls between June and September, supplying Hyderabad with most of its mean annual rainfall.

How to reach Forest College and Research Institute, Telangana

By Train: Trains from main towns operate to Hyderabad and reach the railway stations at Secunderabad, Hyderabad (Nampally) and Kacheguda. It is easier to reach the Institute by getting off at Secunderabad station.

By Bus: Direct bus services to Jubilee Bus Station (JBS), Hyderabad is available from all major towns.

City bus service: Bus No. 227 from Secunderabad station to Bahdhurapalli, get down at Telangana State Forest Academy after Dulapally village. This bus also stops at Jubilee bus station, Secunderabad stop.

Auto service: Auto service is available from Kompally cross on NH 44, the institute is located at 3 kms distance.

Reception: Please report at the Institute reception for the Joining Formalities on 19th August, 2019 along with:

- Submit 4 passport size photographs. Name, father name and DOB are to be mentioned in block capital letters on the reverse of each photo.
- Adhaar card Copy.
- Income certificate issued by concerned authorities.
- Anti Tagging affidavit by student & parent / guardian. (Enclose on website)

Residential Accommodation: Stay at the institute is mandatory. The students will be provided hostel facility. Items that students required to bring are listed below.

List of Items Required:

Bedding & Linen Requirement: Towels, blanket, two bed sheets, one pillow.

Other items required: One Bucket and Mug, Hangers, Clips, Soap box, Water bottle and Water glass, Torch light and other stationary items if you wish to carry.

Lap Tops: The students who have their own laptops may carry their laptops, however it is not essential.

Mobile Phones: Mobile phones are prohibited in the academic block of the campus. Carrying Mobile phones in the Academic Block will result in Confiscation. Do not carry mobile phones to physical training session and sports session also.

Clothing: Students are expected to be well groomed and properly attired and to ensure at all times that they do not present an unkempt or slovenly appearance. It is essential to wear shoe while walking in late hours in evening and early hours in mornings at campus (dark hours)

Class room: The Boys should wear light blue shirt and dark Blue trouser along with black formal shoes and light blue kameez and Dark blue salwar & dupatta for girls along with black formal shoes. Uniform is also compulsory for field visits.

Mess: Students should not come to the mess in shorts and bathroom slippers.

Physical training and Sports: Grey track pant and Blue T-shirt with white shoes.

Formal occasions: On regular uniform dark blue blazer with tie.

Dining Facilities: Dining facilities are provided in the institute. Cooking in the hostel rooms is strictly prohibited. Hygienic food will be served in the mess on payment of monthly charges.

Extra-Curricular Activities: Extensive facilities exist in the institute for extra – curricular activities.

Students may bring personal equipment for games, music, and photography. FCRI encourage students to get ethnic dresses, if they have special occasions and also for participation in cultural programs.

Special Instructions: No leave shall be granted during the period of study at the institute other than scheduled by the FCRI.

Anti-Ragging instructions: University Grants Commission, to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging including any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, in all higher education institutions in the country, and thereby, to provide for the healthy development, physically and psychologically, of all students, the University Grants Commission, in consultation with the Councils, brings forth this Regulation. As per this regulation the students and parents are required to submit the affidavit Annexure I and II.

<u>Accommodation to parents / guardians:</u> Accommodation to parents / guardians will be provided on request at TSFA, Dulapally on payment basis Rs. 400/- per head per day. (Please intimate in advance if required)

Consumption or Possession of Alcoholic Drinks: Students either found in possession of alcoholic drinks or found to have consumed alcoholic drinks will be asked to discontinue the course instantly. This will also invite disciplinary action under the relevant rules. Smoking is strictly prohibited.

Leaving or throwing any kind of litter in campus is strictly prohibited and punishable.

Note – 1: Student should be in possession about Rs. 6,000/- for meeting expenditure towards mess advance for one month, Uniform, Shoe, Blazer and sports dress and other personal requirement during first one month. After wards monthly expenditure is expected to be Rs. 4000/- approximately.

Academic Calendar, Daily Schedule, Detailed Hostel, Library rules, Syllabus Course book shall be given on Admission. It is available on website as well. Student Hand Book upload on site.
