

## **TIGER CENSUS:**

Tiger census conducted once in a four years, All India Tiger Estimation is a national exercise by the National Tiger Conservation Authority and Wild Life Institute of India. The students of forest college and research institute were also included in this prestigious government project held almost for a week and were allotted to six forest divisions of the state inclusive of Amrabad Tiger Reserve and Kawal Tiger Reserve.
